#### Sign up for the community forum to stay updated on all the news!

The Villages at Godley Station's online community forum, hosted on the HOA's website, is gaining traction. It allows residents to communicate with each other, committees, and with board members. as a user by creating an account.

When creating an account, residents must do so using the email address they have on file with Sentry, the HOA's community management agency. Once registration has been submitted, the resident will be approved as a member and will be able to enter the forum, make and respond to posts, and read comments. The forum is also a platform for the HOA board to share news and announcements

## **Updating your home?** Don't forget about the ARC!

The Villages at Godley Station's Architectural Review Committee (ARC) is a volunteer committee responsible for reviewing exterior home changes to ensure they comply with the community's architectural guidelines, as outlined in the HOA's covenants and bylaws. Homeowners must submit an application, construction plans, and a material list for review before making any exterior changes. The ARC reviews applications based on guidelines, not personal opinions, to maintain a consistent appearance and property values throughout the community.

The ARC handles various exterior modifications, including:

- Structures like sheds and pergolas
- Landscaping modifications
- Exterior paint colors and finishes
- Roofing materials
- Fences, satellite dishes, solar panels, and electric vehicle charging stations

To submit an application, homeowners can download a copy of the HOA architectural review form on the community website, providing details such as alteration type, materials, colors, project plans, contractor information, and timeline.
